## Mid-South Star Gaze Guidelines



- Rainwater Observatory, the Bed & Breakfast, and Camp of the Rising Son do not allow drugs, alcohol, or smoking on campus or in its buildings.
- The registration fee for children ages 12 and younger is complimentary. Lodging fees still apply. Regular registration fees will apply to youth and adults ages 13 and up.
   Please Note: This event is primarily geared for adults and supervised older children interested in learning more about astronomy.
- Please include your registration fee with your registration form. Please submit all payments at least one week prior to the event start date. Registration, lodging, and fees are non-refundable for cancellations made less than one week in advance of event.
- As at all star parties, please be courteous to your neighbors. Don't use a telescope unless its owner is present and invites you.
- All flashlights should be covered with red tape or tissue paper. Please refrain from using car lights after dark in the observing area.
- Use of smart phones and other light-emitting devices should be done with discretion and away from the telescopes or camera equipment.
- Please be aware of posts, telescope-related cables and other obstacles on the observatory hill. These can be very difficult to see in the dark.
- After dark, please leave the observing area with your car only during specified time windows and wait until you are past the trees to turn on your headlights. A window between 9:30-10:00 pm will be allowed for anyone to leave the observatory for the evening. We strongly recommend parking as far away from the hill as possible if you will have to leave other than the designated time.
- Due to safety concerns and the expensive and delicate equipment in use, please do not allow children to run or play on the observatory hill or near the buildings at any time.
- In an effort to protect the observatory hill we ask everyone to please be very careful driving your vehicle on the hill. It is best to enter the hill from the top near the Sangre then drive downhill to your selected area.
- Please stop at the Office to register as soon as you arrive.
